KIC SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

KIC SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PACKET—Page 3 of 5 Revised 08/12/2021

1. Eligibility: KIC shareholders or their descendants are eligible to apply.

2. <u>Deadline for full-time and part-time applicants:</u>

Fall.....August 1 Spring.....January 10

Open.....Vocational Program Only

Completed applications must be received by KIC on or before the deadline stated above in considered. Vocational program must be received prior to the first day of training start date.

- 3. The scholarship award will be sent to the school in which the student is enrolled, in the student's name. Verification of enrollment and grades must be sent to KIC each semester, quarter, or trimester. If the student has a credit balance with the school, any excess funds resulting from receiving the KIC scholarship award shall be returned to KIC.
- 4. Students must maintain a <u>cumulative</u> GPA of 2.0. Students will be refused a scholarship for the following semester or quarter if their GPA falls below 2.0, or if the student status drops below the required amount for which they were funded for. Students must be in good standing, and students must let KIC know if they are on academic probation.
- 5. Students must be enrolled in an accredited college or university for 12 or more credits per semester or quarter to be eligible for the full-time scholarship of \$500.00. Students must be enrolled in an accredited college or university for 6-11 credits to be eligible for the \$250.00 part-time award, and 1-5 credits for the \$125.00 part-time award. Students must be enrolled in a vocational program for at least one week of full-time study or the equivalent to be eligible for the short vocational program scholarship of \$250.00. Vocational students with program expenses above \$1,000.00 will be awarded \$500.00; vocational program expenses below \$1,000.00 will be awarded \$250.00. Should the student's enrolment status drop below the awarded amount, the student will be on probation for the next funding cycle. If the student's academic status falls below the awarded amount for that semester, the student will be on probation for the next funding period.
 - *Probation: The student will still be eligible for a scholarship; however, the award amount will be half of the normal amount until the student can improve their GPA of 2.0 or above. Probation does not disqualify the student from future scholarships.
- 6. Filling out and submitting all the information requested above for *New Applicants* (items 1-8) and *Continuing Applicants* (items 1-6) shall constitute a complete application. Vocational program students must fill out and submit all the information requested for *New Applicants*.
- 7. Scholarship Amounts: Subject to the availability of funding, scholarships in the following amounts may be made available on a first-come, first-served basis as follows:
 - --\$500 per semester or quarter for full-time students;
 - --\$250 per semester or quarter for part-time students enrolled in 6-11 credits;
 - --\$125 per semester or quarter for part-time students enrolled in 1-5 credits;
 - --\$500 per program over \$1,000 for vocational program students; and
 - --\$250 per program under \$1,000 for vocational program students.
- 8. All recipients have a 12 full scholarship or \$6,000.00 limit as the maximum funding allowed.
- 9. Scholarship funding is limited and is awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.
- 10. Any applicants that have exceeded the 12 full scholarships will be reviewed case by case.

ELIGIBILITY

KIC shareholders or their descendants are eligible to apply. Students must indicate whether they will be full-time, part-time, or vocational program students. Please carefully review the checklist below. **Students must submit a complete application by the appropriate deadline in order to be considered.**
