



How to get free internet at home

Emergency Connectivity Fund (ECF)

The ECF Program will reimburse schools for the reasonable cost of eligible broadband connections used to help students and staff who otherwise lack access to be able to engage in remote learning.



The **NWABSD** has applied for ECF funding on your behalf and was awarded funding for 10 months at 2Gbps of unlimited internet service through GCI for each eligible student household in **Kotzebue**.

Does your household qualify?



You currently have a student(s) enrolled at the NWABSD and living in your household.



Your student(s) **DO NOT** have sufficient internet access in your home to complete internet-based homework assignments and/or to participate in online video classes simultaneously.



You currently **DO NOT** receive a federal subsidy from the FCC to purchase internet access (i.e., the Emergency Broadband Benefit (EBB), Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) or Lifeline funded internet service).
