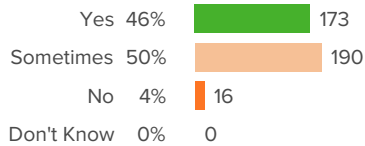

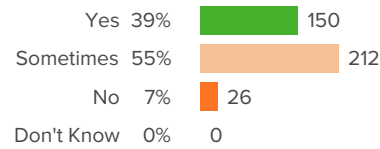

Q.1: Students in this school help each other, even if they are not friends.



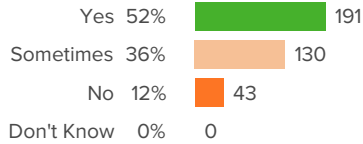

Q.2: Students here treat me with respect.



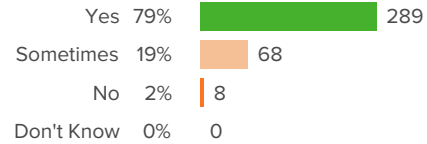

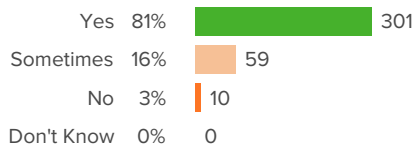

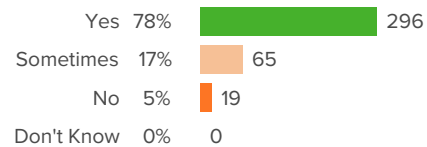

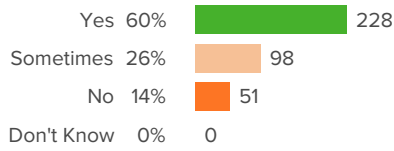

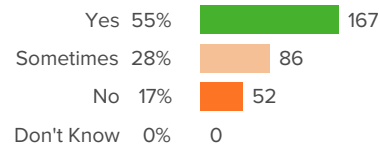

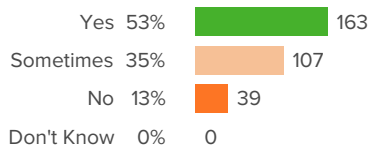

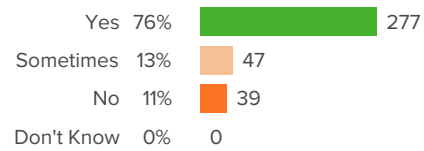

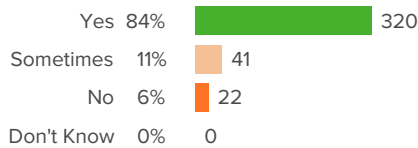

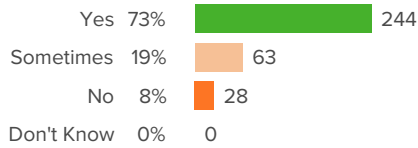

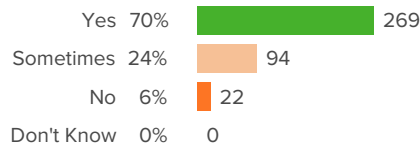

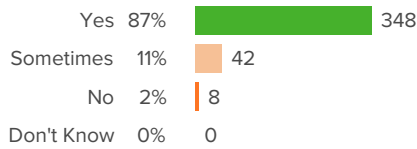

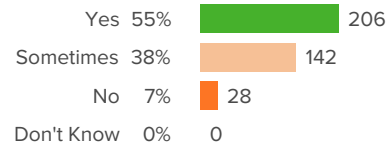

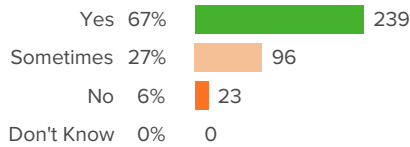

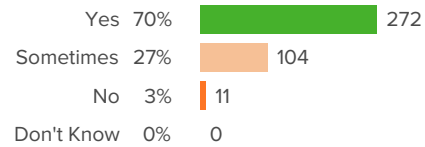

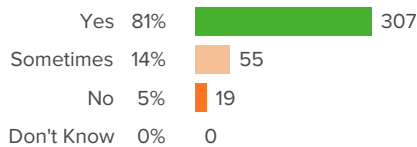

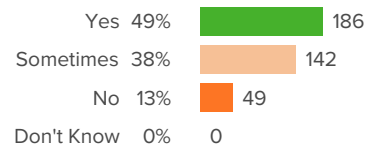

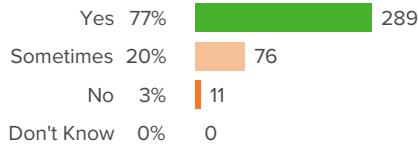

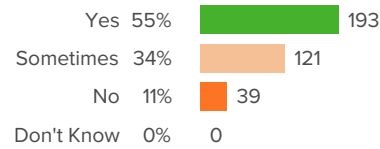

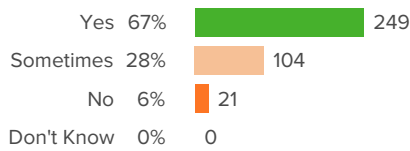

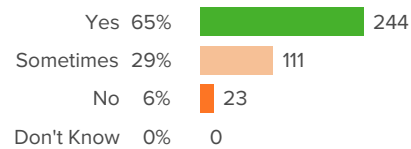

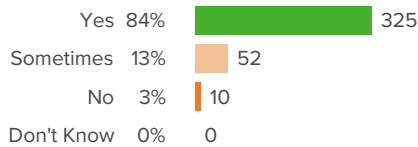

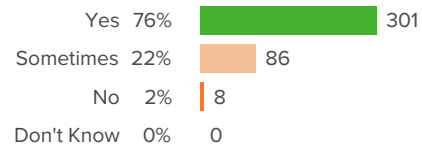

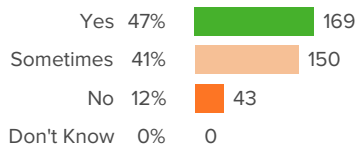

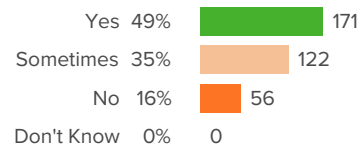

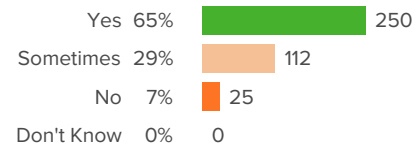
