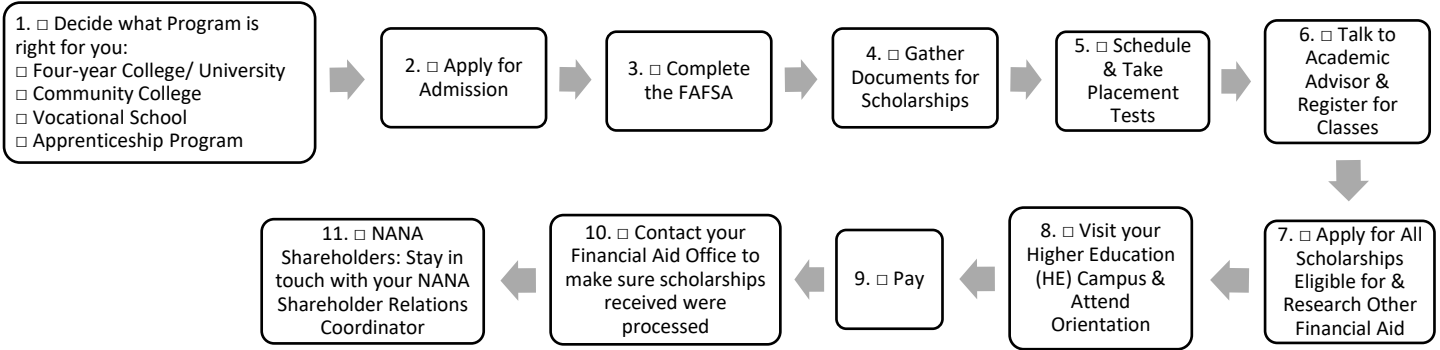

- ☐ FAFSA is the first step in the financial aid process. Use it to apply for federal student financial aid, such as the Pell Grant, student loans, and college work-study. In addition, most states and schools use FAFSA information to award their financial aid. You will need your (and possibly your parent's) Social Security Number, previous year's tax return (if you filed your taxes), and any records of money earned during the previous year.
