What is the ANSEP Middle School Academy?

ANSEP Middle School Academy is an academic and residential experience that emphasizes increasing students' mathematics and science knowledge and skills while introducing them to college life. ANSEP promotes science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) education. Each day students will participate in activities that include problem solving, research, critical thinking and communication skills. Industry professionals, university faculty and ANSEP staff will lead activities. This opportunity is possible and provided for free through partnership with the Northwest Arctic Borough School District (NWABSD)

What is UAA's response to COVID?

UAA takes extra precautions with the care of every student, staff, faculty, and visitor to include procedures in compliance with CDC and local guidance.

All persons, including ANSEP students, chaperones, instructors, and staff, are recommended to wear masks/face coverings regardless of vaccination status.

Who should apply?

NWABSD students currently in grade 6, 7 or 8, who:

- Are interested in STEM,
- Have at least a B average in science and mathematics courses,
- Have not attended a previous ANSEP Middle School Academy *on the UAA campus*,
- Are on track (or can get on-track) to complete Algebra 1 *before* entering high school.

When and where will the ANSEP Middle School Academy occur?

The Academy will be held on the University of Alaska Anchorage (UAA) campus and hosted by ANSEP from **October 25 – October 31, 2022**. Students will be housed on the UAA campus during the program. It is mandatory for all participants to stay in the provided housing for the duration of the Academy. Transportation will be provided between your hometowns and Anchorage.

How do you apply?

- Student (and Parent/Guardian) completes the attached student application form (*pages 3-5*) **OR** fill out the electronic application – see below for details.
- Parent/Guardian signs Transcript Release Form (page 5) authorizing ANSEP to obtain academic records directly from your school district.
- Online Recommendation Forms from CURRENT math and science teacher(s) – see below for details.
- Student-written** essay – see below for details.

Include all application documents together in one packet. Only complete applications will be considered.
The complete application packet should be turned into your school front office by September 16, 2022.
DO NOT mail in paper applications.

What should be included in the student essay?

Students must write a 250-500-word essay that includes:

- Your name (first & last) and current grade level at the top
- WHY you are interested in participating and should be selected
- WHAT you hope to gain from this experience
- HOW this experience can help your future
- Any other info that might relate to the selection process

Selections for the Academy will be made by September 30. You will receive notification, via email and mail, on acceptance status.

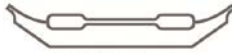

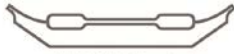

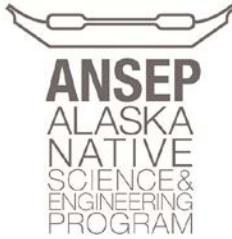
