

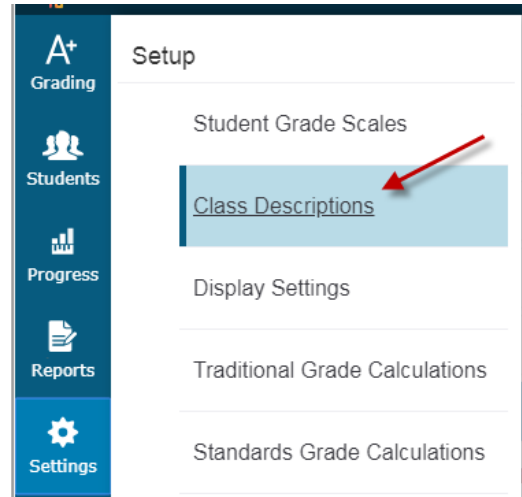
Class Descriptions for Parents
