

## The Peter MacManus Memorial Scholarship Fund

1. A "continuing education" scholarship up to the amount of \$2500 will be awarded to a graduating senior and/or previous applicant continuing on in college in the Northwest Arctic School District. The total award will depend on the number of recipients selected including the number of continuing students receiving scholarships. A student may re-apply each year he/she continues in college.
2. Students should apply for this scholarship by writing a short statement about what they intend to do with their education, what courses of study will be followed, extra curricular activities participated in during high school, and community involvement. Student should mention any special interests and abilities they have, sports activities, hobbies, etc., any awards received or achievements acknowledged. Include an official grade transcript with GPA and a statement of financial need.
3. Student should have written recommendations from a principal and two current teachers sent to the scholarship committee.
4. Students should include their full name, permanent address and phone number. Also include the name of the educational institution you plan to attend, and the address and phone number of their financial aid or business office. If you are awarded a scholarship, you will need to supply your social security number. All this information will be kept confidential except as necessary to process your scholarship funds.
